Retired NSW Police Force constable and NRL named Immortal – John Raper, MBE was one of the guest speakers at the Launch. An Australian former professional rugby league footballer and coach, John played a record 33 test caps between 1959 to 1968 and contested 6 World Cup matches. John captained Australia on 8 occasions and played in 8 consecutive NSWRLF victories for the St George Dragons club. He has since been named as one of the nation's finest footballers of the 20th century. His stories and renditions of life as both a footballer and a police officer were enlightening and amusing.

Patrick Lindsay, on his website described our guest speaker as a "showman, sportsman and survivor" but Bill Harris, who now at 96 once played rugby league for Canterbury-Bankstown in 1943-44, and more importantly is a former member of the NSW Police Force having served for 32 years! He is the oldest-living NSW Detective and is the oldest first grade rugby league player alive. His recollection of stories of his life as a police officer, were extremely detailed and very funny. A gentleman and a pleasure to meet.

Australian author Patrick Lindsay completed the work on

'True Blue...150 Years of Service and Sacrifice' – tracing the Force's remarkable journey from the nation's European birth to today, through the eyes of its members. The book honours the courage, resolution and sacrifices of police and celebrate their contribution to the community, is now on sale.

Commissioner Scipione said it's a significant milestone in the Force's history. "NSW Police Force has come a long way in 150 years and is now one of the largest policing organisations in the English-speaking world – with more than 15,600 sworn officers and close to 4000 civilian staff".

"Patrick Lindsay's book captures the spirit of the Force by interweaving evocative images with stories about the characters and events that have formed our wonderful heritage".

# ANGLING

The angling event for the 2012 NSW Police Games was proudly hosted by the NSW Fishing Club Inc., fishing focused on Lake Macquarie, Swansea Channel and to sea. The competition ran over 48 hours from 12md on Sunday 25th to 12md on Tuesday 27th March 2012.

36 anglers registered for this year's event. Anglers travelled from as far away as Tarcutta, Wagga Wagga and Yass in the South, Gilgandra in the West. Anglers fished using a variety of techniques covering both inshore and offshore fisheries. The majority of anglers caught fish, but the score sheets revealed that the majority of anglers found the fishing more challenging than previous years. Although this year, only 3 of the 36 registered anglers failed to return a legal fish. A catch and release format was utilised with the majority of fish caught returned to the water.

The weather on the Monday proved challenging with high winds making the fishing conditions difficult. Some suffered as a result, but battled through their sea sickness and managed to place on the leader board.

A number of anglers brought their sons, who fished side by side with the older salts. These juniors made a fair show for themselves, placing on the podium. We encourage anglers not to forget their daughters, with 4 lady anglers laying the challenge down to their male counterparts, putting some to shame. These girls can fish. The future of our sport is in the hands of these talented young anglers.

A social BBQ was held on the Monday night for competing anglers to catch up away from the heat of competition. At an informal meeting a vote was taken with a proposed change of location to facilitate the southern anglers that have been travelling north to compete for so many years. At the BBQ and again at the Tuesday presentation the NSW Police Fishing Club ran a raffle and a number of draws which were eagerly supported by the competitors. Over all \$260 was raised which has been proudly donated to the David Rixon memorial fund.

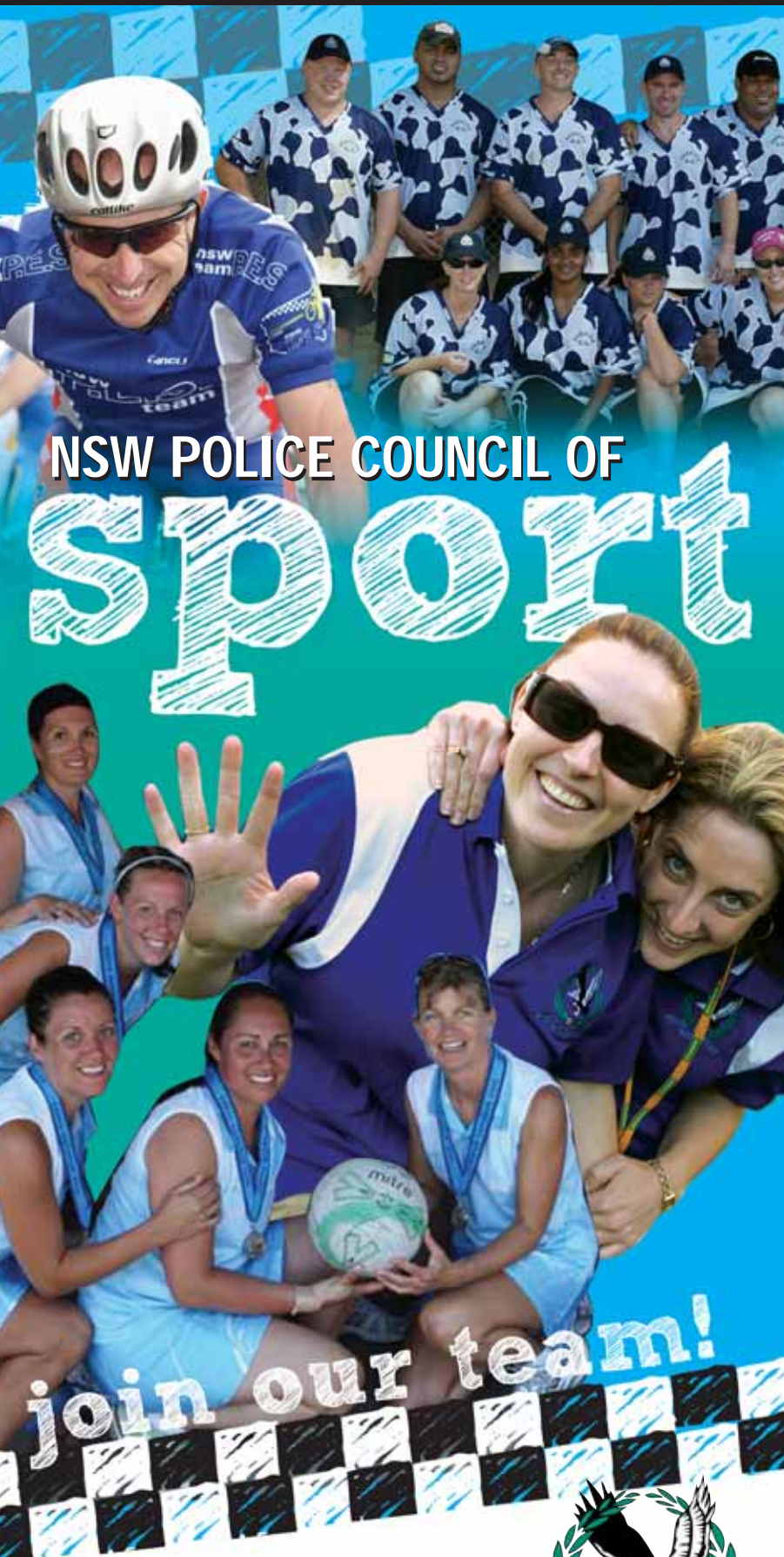

## Teams Event:

This year the teams perpetual trophy was hotly contested with the trophy being secured by Customs with a score of 341 points. NSW Police second with 210 points, closely followed by Corrective Services on 209 points. New to the angling event was the Royal Australian Air Force with a strong fourth with 199 points, followed in fifth by Local Government Council Rangers with 140 points. After such a strong finish in 2011 the RSPCA Inspectorate were forced into relinquishing the trophy after finishing sixth on 86 points. Public Service finished seventh on 65 points and the Retired Police Association eighth on 10 points. The NSW Fire Brigade and NSW Ambulance were missed at this years event, and it is hoped they can return in 2013. The NSW Police Fishing Club is pleased to welcome the competitors from the RAAF and Public Service.

A special thank you to Aus Spin Lures for their generous donation of lures, caps and boat stickers, along with Gansel Australia who provided a selection of fishing tackle, lures and rigs which were presented to medal winning anglers, and given as lucky draws to competitors.
